RESULT OF LAND USE MEETING AT SMITH VOCATIONAL AND AGRICULTURAL H. S. : A ten-person committee has been formed by the Mass. Food and Natural Resources Department and Smith Vocational to consult with and advise the school on their land use policy in compliance with the school's 99 year lease of the land containing the roads and trails upon which our foot races are run.

Our club's chief concerns in mustering the 14+ runners and allies who spoke at the meeting were to secure the continuation of our race series on the course (which we have maintained for 29 years) and secure the protection of the public and farm workers from the many dogs brought to the farmland by their owners or dog-sitting companies, and turned loose - allowed to run wild, defecate on roads and paths, and in fields of hay and food crops, and assault men, women, children and other dogs whose owners obey the law and keep their dogs on leashes. We want the leash law posted and enforced. Of the 37 people who spoke at the meeting the majority spoke in support of our race.
